Scope and Contents

Cynthia J. Little, Ph.D, has been involved with public history and civic life in Philadelphia since the early 1970s. In the 1970s, she founded Feminist Tours of Philadelphia with classmate Barbara Klaczynska. She was also a field organizer in Chicago for the National Abortion Rights League (NARAL). In 1980, Little was a founder of what became National Women's History Month. In Philadelphia, she has served on several boards, including Women's Way, New Century Trust, Muse Foundation for Women in the Arts, Museum Council of Philadelphia and Delaware Valley, and the Pennsylvania Abolition Society. Her work life has included positions at the Philadelphia Area Cultural Consortium, Historical Society of Pennsylvania, and the Philadelphia History Museum. Moreover, she has consulted on numerous public history projects and served on multiple history advisory committees locally and nationally.

This collection consists of papers and material that Little created and collected over the course of her work with a myriad of local and national cultural and women's organizations. Women's rights, history, and health care are prevalent topics throughout. Documents pertain to the Mayor's Commission for Women, Commission on the Status of Women, Illinois Women's History Week, Women's History Institute of Sarah Lawrence College, National Collaborative for

Women's History Sites. Little's professional papers include her writings and articles, calendars, some correspondence, ephemera, and papers related to the New Century Guild/New Century Trust and the Historical Society of Pennsylvania. Tour scripts and research notes are also present. Of note, is Little's collection of radical feminist literature which date mostly from the 1970s and 1980s and include periodicals, papers, and articles. There are two boxes of photographs documenting Little's professional life, including her time at the Historical Society of Pennsylvania.
